YOUR HYGIENE STATION IN THE ORCHARD

Hygiene Kit



Waterproof footwear



Overalls that are washable or disposable



Plastic sheeting



2 sturdy plastic tubs



2 plastic containers
- water
- fungicide



Shoe brush



Spray bottle with methylated spirits or alcohol >70% & water



Alcohol or chlorine wipes



Clean sealable bags for washables & rubbish

Disease

Fungal spores can exist on footwear clothing and easily be moved across the landscape through human activities to create infections in our orchards. Utilising a hygiene kit is a cheap, effective and easy way to manage disease on our farms.

Footwear Hygiene

Hygiene station

Effective against Chestnut blight, *Phytophthora* sp. or other diseases in infected areas with high traffic

Brush System

Simple system used to remove soil from shoes

Hygiene Tub Kit

System using Fungicide, phytoclean, water and brush

Decontamination

Return to the hygiene station after exiting the orchard, clean equipment first, removing organic material before spraying down, and then yourself.

If you forget something you will need to repeat the decontamination procedure.
